Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Kingston Board of Health is offering an H1N1 vaccination clinic on Wednesday, December 16<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 – 8:00 p.m., at the **KES** school cafeteria.

In order to avoid any traffic problems, we ask that you park your car in the large parking lot in front of the school or on the side parking lot. Do not park on the grassy area in the front of the school. This is a fire lane and it is important that we can access in the event of an emergency.

The H1N1 clinic will be administering the flu shot only as this is what is currently available. The clinic will provide a shot to these high risk groups which include:

- \* Children 4 years to 18 years old
- \* Individuals who have daily contact with infants under 6 months old
- \* Pregnant women

As you may know, most individuals will need two doses of this vaccine. If your child has had the first H1N1 shot, this clinic could provide your child with the second shot, as long as it has been three weeks since the last H1N1 shot.

Permission slips are being sent home with your child so that you can fill out the paper work ahead of time to help expedite the process at the H1N1 clinic on December 16<sup>th</sup>. Remember to bring some form of identification indicating that you are a Kingston resident.
