

EPINEPHRINE PROCEDURE

Silver Lake Regional School District

All schools in the Silver Lake Regional School District have standing doctor's orders from the School Physician for epinephrine use in the event of a severe anaphylactic reaction that may occur at school.

- A student with a known allergy is always required to provide the School Nurse with doctor's orders and an emergency care plan at the start of each school year.
- All schools in the Silver Lake Regional School District are stocked with epinephrine that will be utilized in the case of an anaphylactic emergency with any student during the school day should epinephrine be needed.
- Parents have the option to supply an individual epinephrine for their child; However, stock epinephrine which are provided by the school, are available to ALL students.
